

FOX AND GEESE

What do you need:

14 game pieces
(13 of one colour, 1 of another colour)

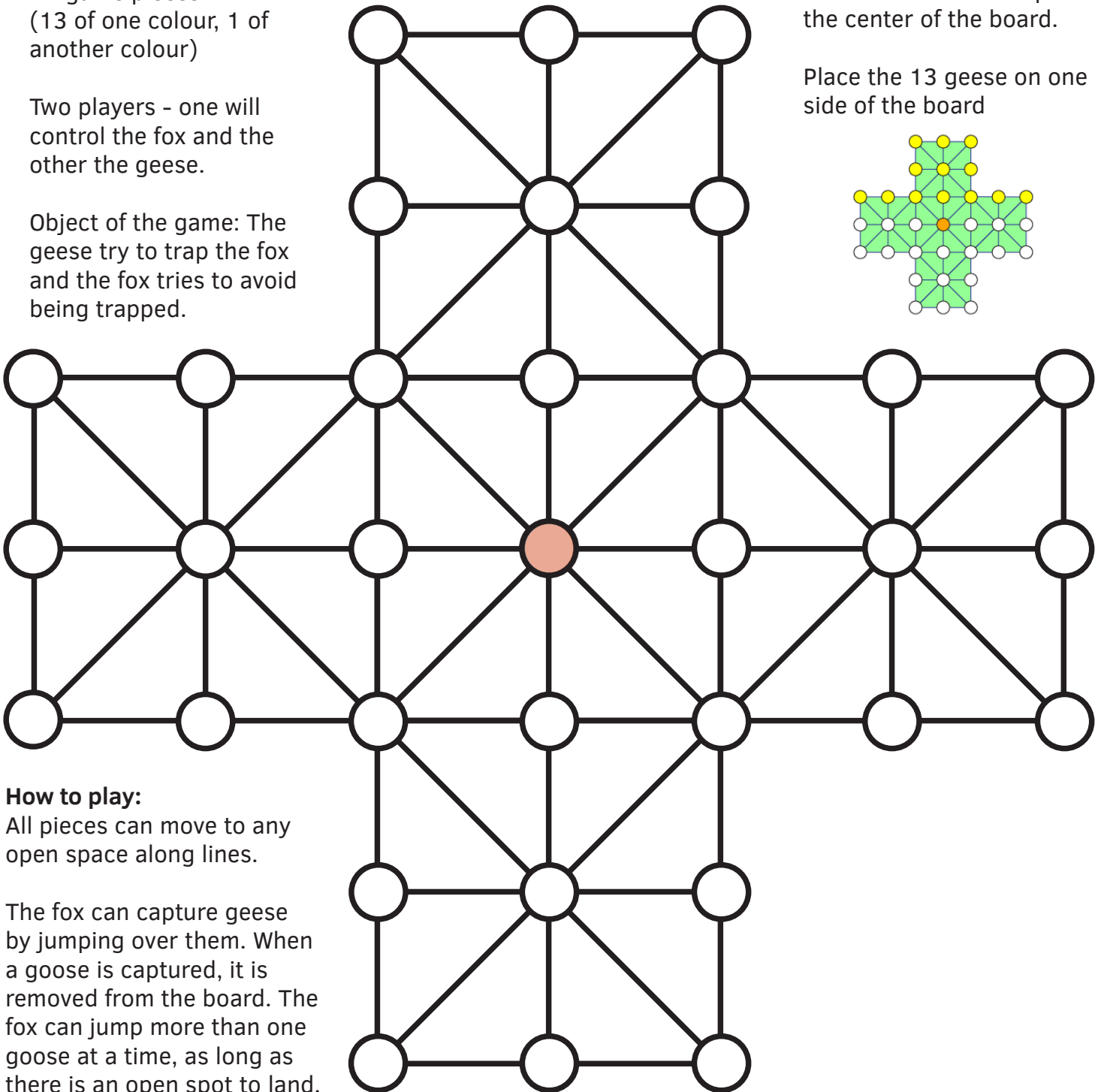
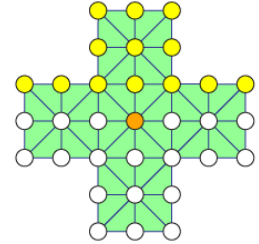
Two players - one will control the fox and the other the geese.

Object of the game: The geese try to trap the fox and the fox tries to avoid being trapped.

Set-up:

Place the fox on the spot in the center of the board.

Place the 13 geese on one side of the board



How to play:

All pieces can move to any open space along lines.

The fox can capture geese by jumping over them. When a goose is captured, it is removed from the board. The fox can jump more than one goose at a time, as long as there is an open spot to land. The fox tries to capture as many geese as possible.

The geese try to crowd and trap the fox so it can't move. If this happens, the geese win.
