

# Trees in Four Seasons

With this activity, kids create a painting showing a (deciduous) tree in each of the four seasons. This is a great activity for demonstrating how trees change in the seasons.

## SUPPLIES

- Paper or canvas
- Newspaper or plastic tablecloth
- Paint brushes, water cups and papertowel
- Something to dot with (q-tips, cotton swaps, pencil eraser, buttons, tissue paper)
- Paint (at least green, white, yellow, red, blue) - you can mix colours to make other shades like orange and brown
- Paint tray, plate or cups

## INSTRUCTIONS

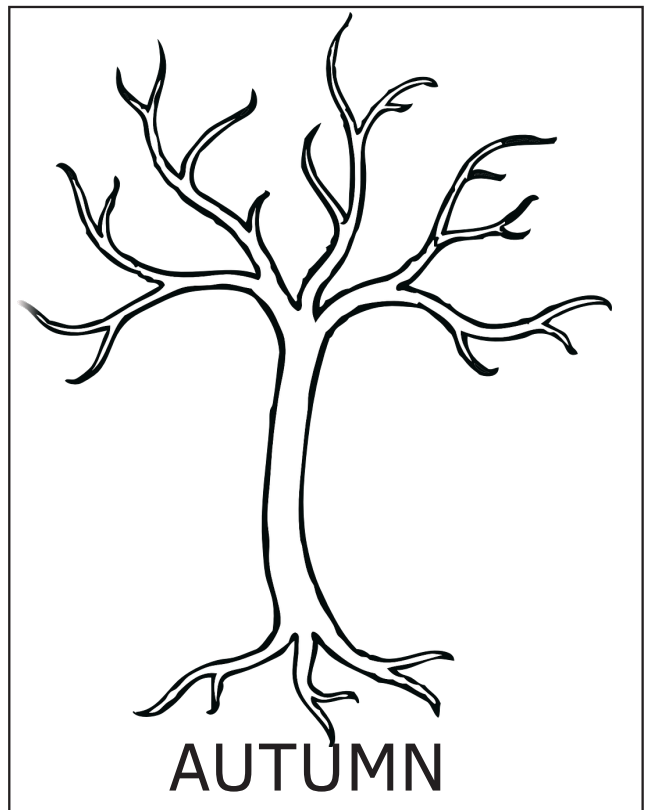
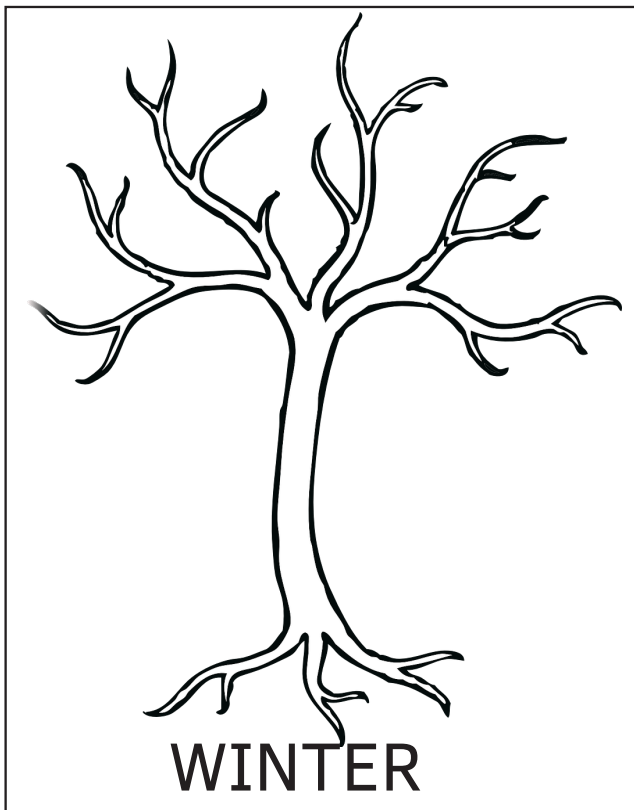
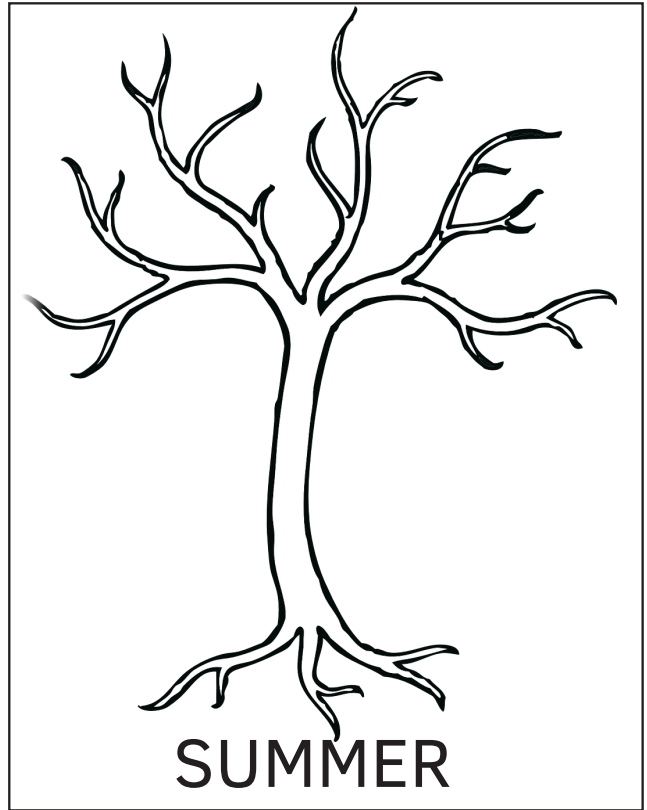
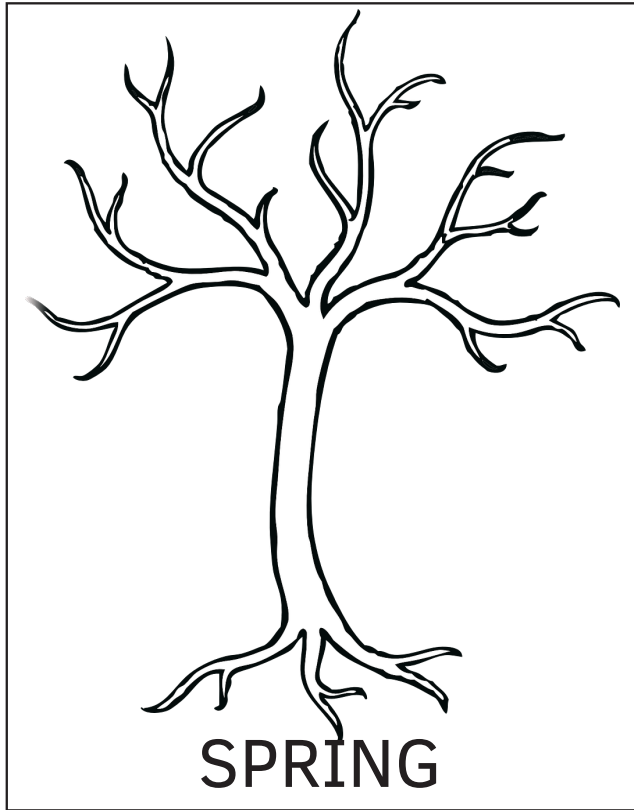
- Choose how you would like to illustrate your tree (see pictures to the right and templates below). You might also choose a specific type of tree (e.g. apple).
- Begin by painting or colouring the background and let it dry
- Draw, colour or paint the trunk and branches and let it dry
- Add dots of colour according to the season. For Fall you may wish to show leaves falling from the tree. For Winter you may wish to show falling snow.

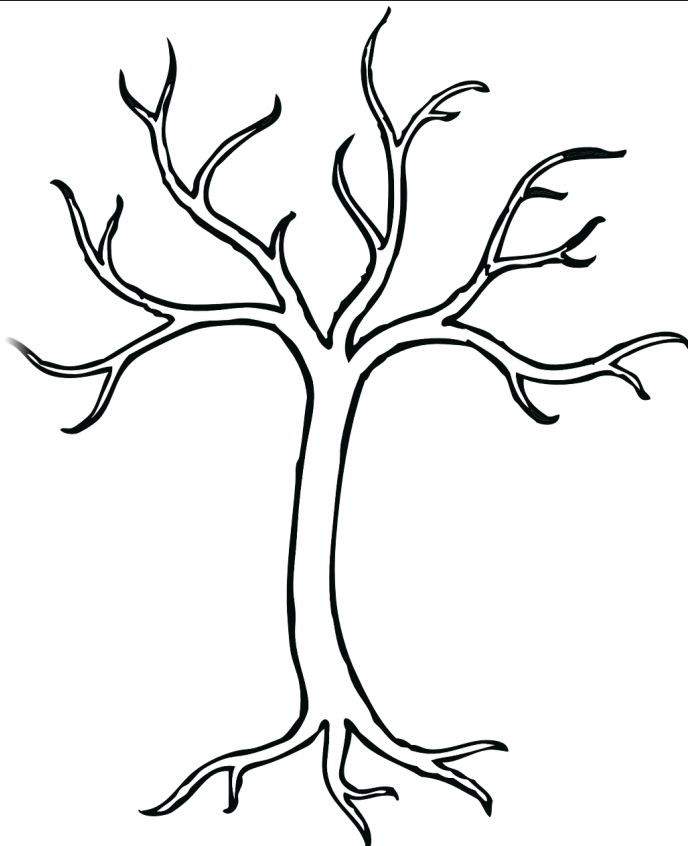


Weather is getting warmer

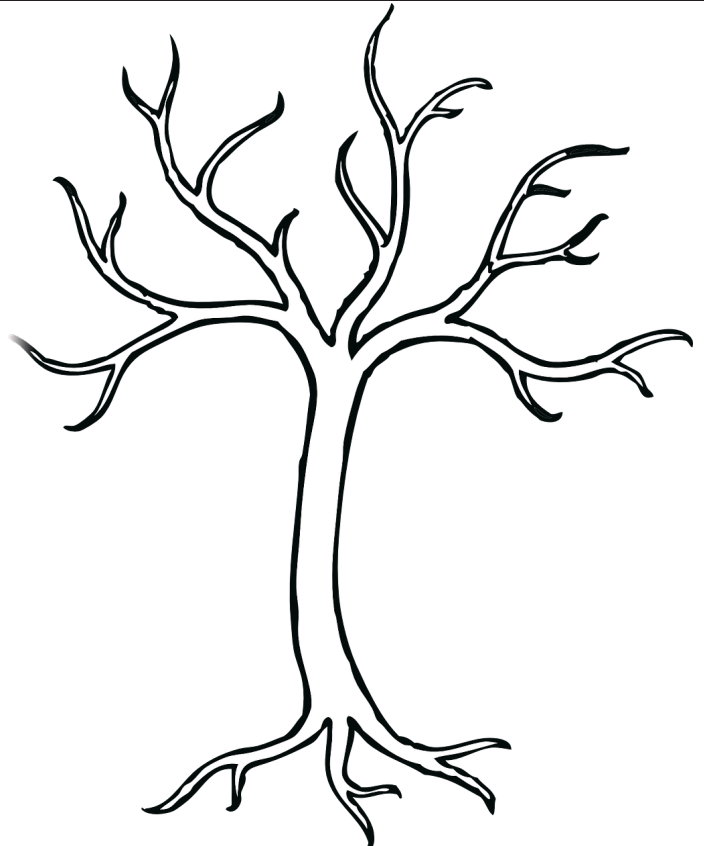


Weather is getting colder

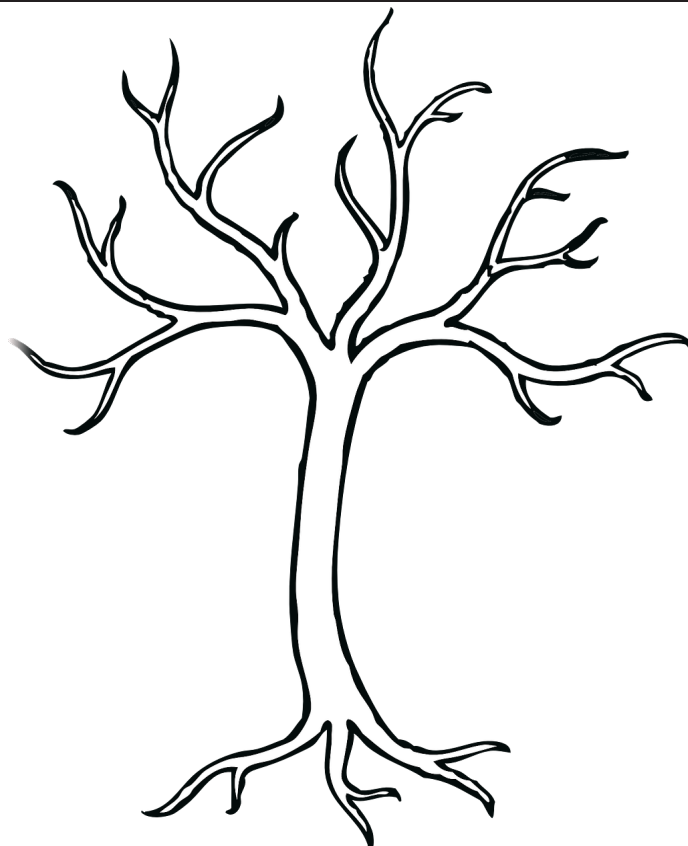




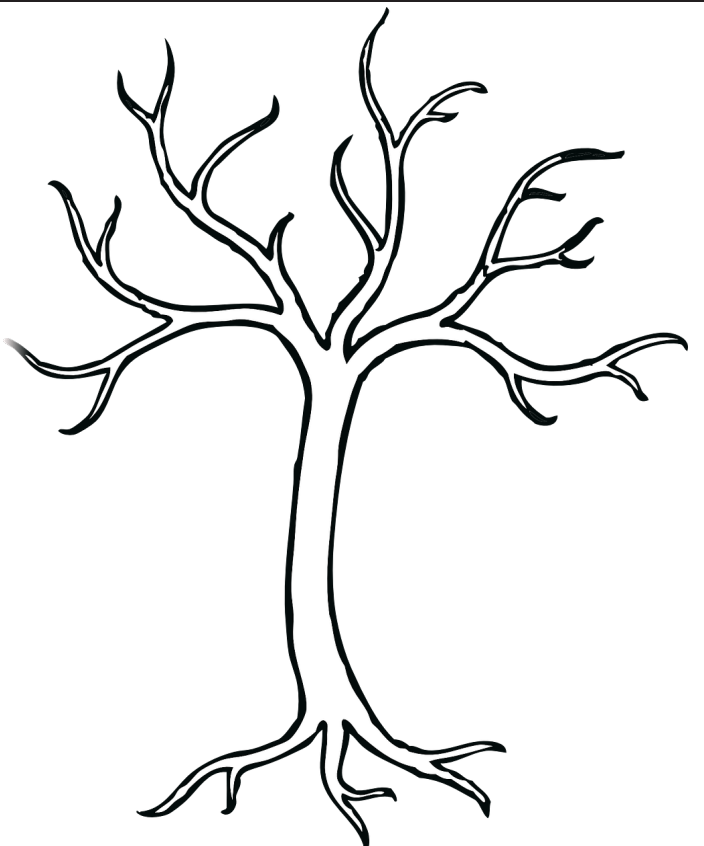
